### Parent/Guardian Elections



School Community Councils are comprised of elected parents and/or guardians whose children attend the school, elected employee representatives, and the school principal. As directed by state law, School Community Councils (SCC) review achievement data, provide input on school improvement plans, allocate LAND Trust funds to assist the school in reaching achievement goals, and address other school activities and concerns. The SCC is required to meet at least four times per year at a time that is convenient to the majority of the members.

The community elects parent representatives to the SCC for two-year terms. To be eligible, a parent or guardian must have a student enrolled in the school for at least one of the years and may not be employed by the school for more than six hours per month.
