2. Landtrust discussion [Tom]

- First draft was submitted to the state today.

- The next time we meet we should start deciding how to spend our money for next year.
- Mr. Sherwood reviewed the school land trust plan.
- LIA (Latinos in Action) program was explained. Program started second semester last year.
- The DIGGERS program was reviewed.
- AVID (advancement via individual determination). Not funded through landtrust. The program focuses on students that are capable of doing AP and Honors work but for some reason choose not to.
- Some funds go towards salaries for tech support here at the school.
- All CRT testing will be done electronically this spring.
