1. Welcome – Kelly Christensen
2. Reminder of Graduation Discussion 2014 – Kelly Christensen
3. Media – Kelly Christensen
 - a. The media contacted members of the SCC last month to see if the hazing incident was discussed in SCC. The question was brought up what should the protocol be for members to speak with the media. Mr. Sherwood pointed out that the SCC meeting is an open and public meeting. He cautioned us to be sensitive towards the privacy of the students at JHS. Kelly also mentioned that members could just refer those asking to the minutes that are posted on our web page.
4. Orientation Day – Mr. Sherwood
 - a. Mr. Sherwood presented the plan for freshman and sophomore orientation that is scheduled to take place on August 16th. Tom asked for input from the counsel to increase attendance on this day.
 - i. Peggy Johnson's hair looks nice and she mentioned that we should try and seek permission to let the 9th and 10th graders out a day early, which could be traded for the day after graduation.
5. Tennis Courts – Mr. Sherwood
 - a. The current tennis courts are not playable. The district is going to replace current courts and add three more for a total of eight courts.
 - b. The new courts will be built towards the current drivers ed range. The new drivers ed range will be moved to the southeast corner of the parking lot.
6. Basketball Coach – Mr. Sherwood
 - a. Mr. Sherwood announced the hiring of a new boys basketball coach, Trace Bevell.
7. Common Core – Mr. Sherwood
 - a. The new math core was presented and explained by Mr. Sherwood.
 - b. Secondary math 1 or honors – Freshmen
 - c. Secondary math 2 or honors – sophomore
 - d. Any 8th grade student started in the old path will continue in the old path. Ie if they are currently in Geometry they will take alg. 2 next year rather than secondary math 1.
 - e. He class of 2017 will have to PASS secondary level math 1,2,&3. Math level 3 is equivalent to precalculus.
8. New Teachers – Mr. Sherwood – Mr. Sherwood mentioned that JHS will have 28 new teachers on staff next year.
9. AP Homework – Peggy –
 - a. A discussion of AP summer homework was brought up. Mr. Sherwood explained the time restraints involved with the classes in preparing them for the AP test.
