I. Counseling Center – Spears

a. Counseling center update

i. Spears explained what senior green sheets are and how they visit all senior English classes monthly. On the back of each green sheet available scholarships are listed. He also discussed the text101 program. The text101 program sends messages via text to students with upcoming announcements.

b. 9<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade CCRP

i. College and Career Readiness Plan. Seniors will meet with counselors once per quarter. Counselors have visited the ninth grade classes to introduce the purpose of the counseling center. Counselors will meet with all ninth graders individually in January.

II. AP & ACT Data Review – Sherwood

a. Mr. Sherwood presented the Data to the SCC.

III. School Grade Discussion – Sherwood

a. Mr. Sherwood discussed and presented how the grading works. The grading is calculated on:

- i. Achievement – proficiency tests
  - ii. Sufficient Growth – student growth percentile. Growth is compared to other students in the state that scored the same on the CRTs.
  - iii. College and Career readiness points – strictly graduation rate. Jordan’s graduation rate was 80%.
- IV. Land Trust – Sherwood – reallocation of funds. No more money is needed, just reallocated. A motion and vote was made, taken, and passed unanimously to approve the following.
  - a. Modify money spent for Diggers Class to pay for TEENS ACT.
  - b. Modify IPAD LAB to help pay for new computer lab
  - c. Modify the 4 study skills classes and change the schedule to reflect 3 study skills classes and 2 ELL classes.
- V. Graduation – Sherwood
  - a. Mr. Sherwood sent a survey out to the parents of the senior class. Option 1 was to hold it at the Maverick center. Option 2 is to hold it on the JHS football field. 60 % want the football field and 40% voted Maverick Center. Graduation will be at 7:00 pm on the football field unless otherwise announced.

- The AP data/ACT Data/ School grading data will be emailed to members of the SCC.
- Mr. Sherwood explained AVID (advancement via individual determination) and the strategies being implemented here at JHS through the AVID program. Jordan has 150 students enrolled in AVID. The goal of the students is to be accepted and enroll in a 4-year university.
- Mr. Sherwood explained that when a student transfers to Entrada that student is then counted as a JHS drop out.
