

Jordan HEART Beets

What: A school wide positive behavior recognition program to show appreciation for students who are exhibiting HEART (Honesty, Effort, Accountability, Respect, Tolerance)

Who: Every student can earn a Heart Beet for demonstrating any of the HEART positive behaviors. Any administrator, teacher or staff member can give a student a Heart Beet

Why: To reinforce positive behaviors in our students.

How: When a student gets a Heart Beet, he/she just needs to bring it to any administrator to exchange for a small treat (Jordan pen/pencil, lanyard, etc). Once the student turns in his/her ticket, their name will be entered in a weekly drawing for different prizes.

When: Drawings will be held every Friday for a variety of prizes (free dance tickets, Jordan apparel, Iceberg shakes, restaurant certificates, certificates for food at JHS games, 7-11 cards); students will also be entered in a year-end drawing for larger prizes (TBD).

Where: Students can turn in their tickets to **any administrator**; if a student wins a prize in the drawing, it will be delivered to the student in their 2nd or 6th period.
