

Jordan High School Student Government Application Honor Code

As a candidate and elected officer, I am entrusted by my peers, administration, and faculty, to represent and serve the student body of Jordan High School with dignity. As long as I am a candidate or hold a school office, my actions shall be those that reflect pride, respect, and dedication for my school, my community, and myself.

I do hereby acknowledge the existence of this Honor Code and will support an environment at Jordan High School, which values integrity, honesty, and ethical conduct.

As a candidate:

1. I must be a registered to attend Jordan High School for the 2020-2021 school year. If I live within another school's boundaries, I must have completed a school permit to attend Jordan. I must also be enrolled at Jordan High School for 8 full classes.
2. I have a minimum GPA of a 3.0 for 3 of the last 4 quarters and no quarter with an F. I understand that if I am elected to office but do not maintain a 3.0 GPA for the 4th quarter of this year, I will be removed from office.
3. I will adhere to all Jordan High School campaign policies.
4. I will uphold the Jordan High School constitution, its obligations and requirements.
5. I agree to fulfill all obligations of the office.
6. I will not solicit from any teacher, counselor, staff member, or administrator any change of an academic grade.
7. I will adhere to all Canyons School District & Jordan High School policies (e.g., alcohol and drugs, safe schools, social media rules, etc.)
8. I understand that if I do not make a 3.0 GPA during the year, I will be placed on probation. Furthermore, I understand that if after that quarter of probation I still do not attain or maintain a 3.0 GPA, I will be released from office.

As an Officer:

1. I understand that the role of a Student-Body or Class Officer is primarily an opportunity to serve the Jordan High School student body.
2. I understand that the role of Student Officer requires me to be in school for the entire academic day. I will not be able to be on work release or attend the Tech Center while I am an officer.
3. I understand that as an officer, I represent the Jordan High School student body and will act in compliance with all rules, policies, and standards.
4. I understand that the student government class is a graded class and that preparation, participation, attendance, promptness, and attitude all determine my academic grade.
5. My attendance at summer meetings and events is mandatory.
6. If I fail to meet eligibility standards (3.0 GPA) during the fourth quarter after elections, I will be removed from office.
7. If I fail to meet eligibility standards (3.0 GPA) during any quarter, I will be placed on probation. If I fail to meet eligibility a second time, I will be removed from office.
8. If I am charged with a criminal act (including complicity), I may be removed from office without option of appeal.
9. I am required to donate many hours before, during, and after school to the improvement of Jordan High School. Many hours during the summer will be dedicated to planning activities and preparing posters for the upcoming year.
10. There will be an estimated cost of approximately \$700 throughout the year. This includes the sweater (\$300), t-shirt (\$25), and sweatshirt (\$75), and summer camp (\$300). Any student on a fee waiver will have these fees waived.
11. I understand that violation of the Student Code of Conduct may result in probation or removal from office.
