- 2) Review of December Meeting Minutes Randy Johnson

Members reviewed December meeting minutes. Motion to approve the minutes. Seconded. Approved unanimously.

- 3) Review of CSIP Budget & Expenditures Wendy Dau

Wendy explained that the current budget didn't show many expenditures because payroll had not caught up with the report. There should be about \$20,000 coming out each month for payroll, but the statement did not reflect this. We will look at it again in a month to determine if we need to adjust expenditures.

- 4) Review of Summer AVID Bridges Data Ryan Durant

Data shows that students who attended the Summer Bridges Program have been performing better than the students who were invited but did not attend, particularly in that fewer of these students are in the at-risk category for GPAs, attendance, and number of D's and F's. Furthermore, the students who participated in the summer program have a GPA that is .42 points higher than their peers. Wendy will go to the Board to ask for support to continue this program for the upcoming summer.

Similar to program at Hillcrest - did not do Avid curriculum

Wendy did discuss that she and Hillcrest principal, Greg Leavitt, are looking into a summer credit recovery program to help improve graduation rates.
